PROJECT

Provided comprehensive reproductive health education to at-risk youth and young adults at Lucille Gorham Intergenerational Community Center (IGCC) in Greenville, North Carolina and the Jack Minges Boys & Girls Club in Winterville, North Carolina. The initiative educated 2nd to 12th graders about age-appropriate topics.

SERVICES PROVIDED

- Biweekly 60-minute educational workshops over two 12-week periods
- Rights. Respect. Responsibility. Curriculum used

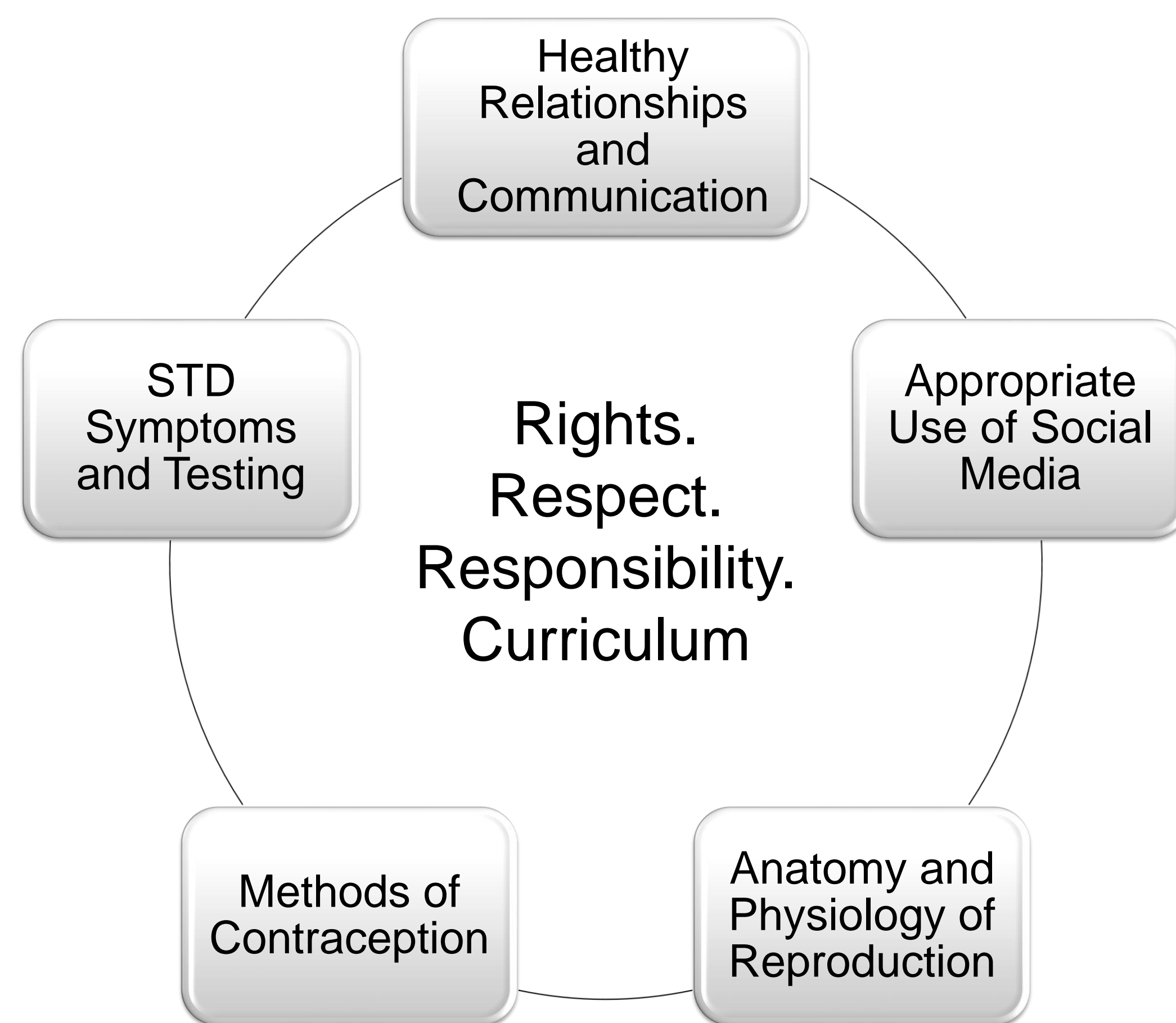


Figure 1- Rights. Respect. Responsibility. Curriculum Contents

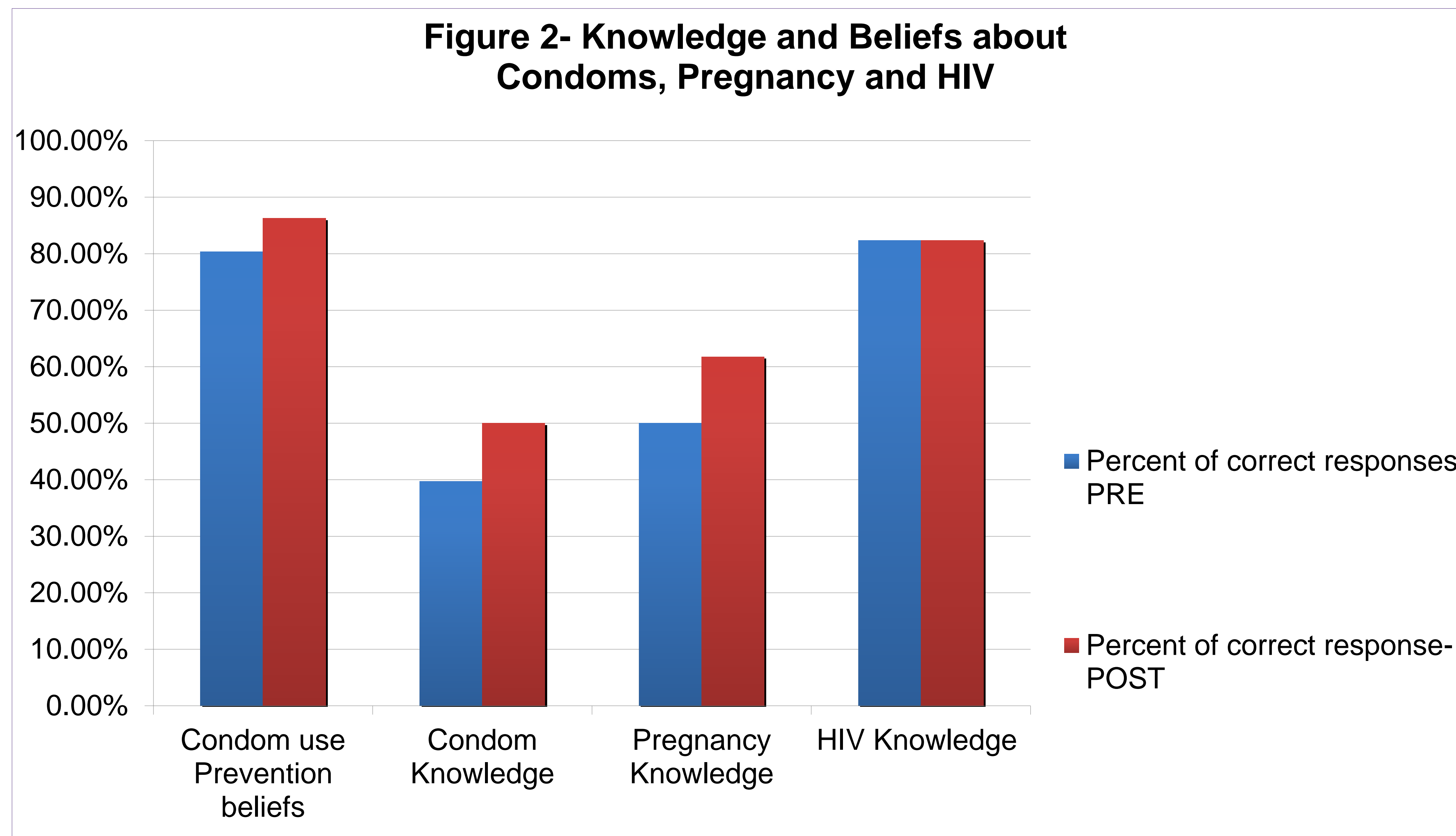
RESULTS

Educational Goals:

- 18 out of 41 middle and high school students at the Boys and Girls Club regularly participated in the program and had an increase in mean knowledge score from pre- to post-class.
- 30 out of 40 2nd - 7th grade students at the IGCC regularly participated in the program and had an increase in mean knowledge score from pre- to post-class.

Measurable Outcomes:

- 18 out of 41 middle and high school students at the Boys and Girls Club regularly participated in the program and achieved the following:
 - 12 out of 18 saw an increase in self-efficacy from baseline to post-assessment.
 - 16 out of 18 had an increase in condom use and comfort asking about using a condom.



SUSTAINABILITY

- PREP will be sustained at the Brody School of Medicine by two new NC Schweitzer Fellows: Camille Bauer and Olivia Campbell.
- They will be expanding the program to include other units within Boys & Girls Clubs of the Coastal Plain while also adding a domestic violence educational component.
